Coronavirus Restrictions

At the time of publication, this Walks Programme is under restriction from Government social distancing rules and Ramblers' own limitations, in the interests of personal and national safety, to stop the spread of the Covid-19 virus. We have produced this limited Walks Programme, so that we will have the base to build on when we are finally allowed to continue with our Group walks.

Ramblers have approved an increase to the size of group walks in England and Wales. For the time being, the group size can now be a maximum of **30 people**. **That is, walk leader plus 29 others, though leaders may reduce this number.**

If you wish to join a walk, please contact the leader and register your interest. It is a 'first come first served' basis, so please allow for others to have a chance and perhaps go onto a waiting list after you get on a couple of walks. **Until further notice, these walks are for Waveney Group members only.**

There will, no doubt, be further updates to the restrictions; hopefully, in the form of relaxation of numbers allowed in groups.
