## THE WALKS:

These tracks have been recorded using a handheld GPS receiver.

Please note the cautions for each walk.

These list the more obvious hazards or potential problems.

- 1 Felixstowe to Trimley - 8.3 Miles - Logged and checked
- 2 Trimley to Derby Road - 11 Miles - Logged and checked
- 3 Derby Road to Ipswich - 7.4 Miles - Logged and checked
- 4 Ipswich to Woodbridge - 10.8 Miles - Logged and checked
- 5 Woodbridge to Wickham Market - 7.3 Miles - Outline plan NOT checked
- 6 Wickham Market to Saxmundham - 10 Miles - Outline plan NOT checked
- 7 Saxmundham to Darsham - 6.9 Miles - Logged and checked
- 8 Darsham to Halesworth - 9.5 Miles - Outline plan NOT checked
- 9 Halesworth to Beccles - 11 Miles - Logged and checked
- 10 Beccles to Oulton Broad South - 9.5 Miles - Logged and checked
- 11 Oulton Broad South to Lowestoft - 10 Miles - Logged and checked
