Coronavirus Restrictions

This Walks Programme is under scrutiny from Government and Ramblers, in the interests of personal and national safety, to stop the spread of the Covid-19 virus. We have produced this limited Walks Programme, so that we will have the base to build on when we are finally rid of restrictions to Group walks.



RAMBLERS advice for members in England from June 8th onwards:

‘The UK government roadmap for lifting lockdown means people in England can now walk together outside. Ramblers group walks and volunteer activities can also resume, following Covid-secure guidance.’

‘Ramblers group walks: Covid-secure group walks are classified by the UK government as 'organised physical activities' and can take place in any number. Car-sharing and coach rambles can resume.’

Leaders, though, may indicate a lower number acceptable on their walks by the inclusion of a ‘max’ number. If you wish to join a walk, please contact the leader and register your interest, for NHS contact tracing purposes, and, when walking, please maintain social distancing. For now, at least, leaders will need to do a Risk Assessment, as usual, and take a register of walkers details (name & phone no.) to send to Roger, who will endeavour to keep the Group informed, as best he can, of further changes to Ramblers regulations, and update this Programme as and when required.
