## New Walkers

If you are a new walker with the group, please wear suitable clothing and footwear for the weather and the area in which you will be walking; if in doubt, contact the leader for advice. We want you to enjoy walking with us and you would do well to be comfortable while doing so. Bring a drink, especially in warmer weather, and some food, as we usually have a short 'apple' stop and, on longer walks, a 'picnic lunch' where stated.

## Fitness and Walk Grades

Waveney Ramblers leads walks at a moderate and brisk pace.

If we get volunteers, we'd like to lead slower and perhaps even faster walks.

### Wednesday Shorter Walks - Moderate

A typical walk is five miles and takes about two hours. That's 2.5 mph overall average and 2.8 mph while on the move. The group stops for a brief snack about half-way round the walk. Covid permitting, some of the Wednesday walkers have a pub lunch after the walk.

### Sundays and Longer Walks - Brisk

A typical walk is ten miles. Our moving average pace is 3 mph, sometimes a bit more on easy terrain. The walk is completed in under four hours. We have a picnic lunch, rushed if it's cold and wet, more leisurely in fine summer weather.

## Leisurely, Speedy and Doggy Volunteers Needed
