

# Waveney Ramblers Waveney Way 1 Ness Point, Corton and the Gull Wing

Track: [TM 55224 94536](#) [GPX for SatNav](#) 5 or 8.2 Miles Updated: 2024

Park in Whapload Road (Sparrows Nest).

Consider reversing this walk if it's windy. Along the sea wall it's very exposed. The map shows more sheltered alternatives.

Head west into the park land and aim for the NW corner.

At the bottom of The Ravine, go left, SW, up steep steps.

Visit the Naval War Memorial, then head NW to the ironwork bridge over the ravine.

Cross the bridge and head left, west, along North Parade.

Turn right, NW, along the A12. Cross at the pelican crossing.

Head roughly south along the shared cycle and footpath disused railway line.

This path bends SW and later south again.

At a staggered crossroads, go ahead, south. Merge south into Barnards Way.

Cross the retail parking diagonally, SE.

Head down a bank and cross Peto Way.

Head east, under the Gull Wing overpass.

Circle left onto Denmark Road, then left, across the Gull Wing bridge, south.

Turn left, east, along Waveney Drive.

Turn left, north, Asda right. Follow the waterside path.

Turn right, east, and head to Belvedere Road.

Note the fisherman memorial and stay close to the river.

Merge into Pier Terrace and head north across the bascule bridge.

Turn right into Waveney Road, harbour right. Merge NE, into Battery Green Road.

Turn right, east, into Hamilton Road.

At the end, use the steps to get to the sea wall path. Head North to Ness Point.

Continue north along the sea wall.

For a shorter walk, head through the caravan park back to the car park.

The full walk continues north along the sea wall path.

Cut diagonally, NW, across the Gunton Warren car park.

Leave via the narrow vehicle exit and cross Links Road.

Head north into the trees. Continue north, slightly uphill to an unexpected spring.

Cross the stream and continue north along the beach.

Turn left, west, and head towards the Dip Farm car park.

Continue west passing the coffee house and Pleasurewood Hills, right.

Turn left, SE, along a woodland path towards Gunton, Saint Peter's church.

Turn left, east, along Hubbard's Loke. Turn right, south along Corton Road.

Turn left, east, along Links Road. Don't drop down too far.

Turn right, south, along Gunton Cliff and later North Parade.

Turn left, down steps, emerging at the bottom of The Ravine.

Head left to return to the car park.

There is a useful cafe in the Sparrows Nest park.
