Park in the pay-and-display car park nearest the river and ferry.

From the car park, head NW along the river bank path and Waveney Way.

At the bridge, don't cross. Instead head left, SW, along the disused railway.

When Palmer's lane bends left, take the second path, right, SW.

Follow the path for 120 metres, then turn left, roughly south.

Continue south to Saint Andrew's Church.

Cross the B1387 and continue south.

The lanes soon become a footpath.

Follow the path south and later west as it gradually bends.

Don't drop down to the marshes here.

The path enters woodland and meanders mostly west via an old pill box.

Follow the path out of the wood, SW, across a reed bed and board walk.

Turn right, NW, along another woodland path.

Turn right, north and soon left, west. The path bends right, north.

Head to Lodge road and cross over.

Enter the meadow and follow the left-most path, west.

At trees, the path bends right, north.

At the end of the meadow, rejoin the Waveney Way and head right, NE.

Follow the B1387, east, for 170 metres.

Turn left, NW, and follow the path close to the disused railway.

In a slight dip, where many paths meet, turn right, SE, towards the village.

Follow this path, crossing lanes. The path gradually bends left, NE.

Cross Palmer's Lane and continue NE, not on Palmer's Lane.

Turn right, east, soon SE, along another footpath.

Turn left, NE, along Leverett's Lane.

Follow this to the village green.

In the village there are two pubs, toilets and tea rooms.

Head NE back to the river and car park.
